Elkus Manfredi Architects was the master planner and the lead design architect for CityPlace, the award-winning redevelopment of approximately 72 acres of land in the heart of West Palm Beach. CityPlace Tower is the latest addition to that development. Elkus Manfredi was the design architect for CityPlace Tower and Schwab Twitty & Hanser Architectural Group was the architect of record.

The 18-story, Class A office tower is the first major new office building in 15 years for downtown West Palm Beach. CityPlace Tower is defined by its iconic architecture, advanced technology systems, and luxury amenities including concierge service, valet parking, and a fully-equipped conference center. Continuous retail at street-level activates the pedestrian environment. The 300,000-square-foot tower also features four levels of parking. Built to post-Hurricane Andrew construction standards on one of the highest land elevations in the city, the tower enables tenants to operate continuously during the most severe weather conditions.
