The French corporation Dassault Systèmes is a world leader in 3D Product Lifecycle Management. The company's new Americas Campus represents the strategic consolidation of its Massachusetts brands, bringing 900 employees into a shared culture to support the DS "One Company" mission and empower everyone — researchers, designers, clients, and consumers — to more seamlessly innovate, share, and experience in 3D.

The 212,000-square-foot offices include an 8,000-square-foot executive briefing center with customer gallery, state-of-the-art virtual reality room, customer and employee computer training labs, and datacenter; 86,700 square feet of open workstations on two floors; a fitness center; cafeteria; and dedicated outdoor meeting courtyard.

Elkus Manfredi's design embodies the DS brand as a worldwide hi-tech innovator with a distinctly French character. Sophisticated all-white spaces are punctuated by pops of vibrant color, glass-fronted offices and multiple espresso bars invite collaborative creativity, and meeting rooms of all sizes feature cutting-edge communication technologies to nurture the collective brainstorming that fuels DS's success. Open workstation configurations break the conventional rules of the standard dense-pack, facilitating reclustered while delivering more efficient metrics — and their associated cost savings — than the standard grid model.
